December 9th	Baby Night/Pajama Night Dress like a baby and bring in your baby pictures to share with the group or wear your favorite pajama (must be rated "G" appropriate).
January 13th	Sports Team Night Clubbers come to club dressed in their favorite jersey, T-shirt, hat, or sports outfit.
February 10th	Black History Night Clubbers dress and/or impersonate an African/African American person past or present. Tell the story of your favorite African American hero.
March 9th	Flash Light Night Clubbers bring your flash lights, or lanterns. Let's have Council time in the dark with our flash lights.
April 13th	Show and Tell Bring something or someone special you would like to share with the group during Council time.
May 11th	Backwards Night Clubber wear their uniforms and clothes backwards. Awana schedule will be backwards. Leaders are asked to join in the fun.
